- Supporting/Creating family engagement activities
- Engaging children, families, and the community in educational activities and outcomes
- Becoming familiar with community in order to individualize services
- Developing and participating in community service activities

- Some college in education, social work, sociology, family and community studies, political science, psychology and human development, preferred
- U.S. citizen, natural, or lawful permanent resident age 18 or older
- Bilingual
